Engaging with Global Links is a wonderful team-building experience and offers your employees an opportunity to connect outside of their regular work environment while also doing good.

We begin with a tour and discussion of our work which adds to the experience, as volunteers learn about and connect to the need/impact of their time. Your team will then assist us by sorting/packing medical supplies to help improve healthcare in communities with need. We also have conference space where your team can bring in food and eat together and/or meet before or after your volunteer shift.

We reserve Fridays for Custom Corporate Group Volunteer/Team Building Experiences. We are also open to other days of the week as available. Groups can choose a shift from either 9:30am-12:00pm or 12:30-3:00pm.

We ask Corporate Groups to make a donation to go along with their volunteer shift. This helps deliver the items you sort and pack to where they are needed.

All in-person volunteering takes place at our headquarters in Green Tree, Pittsburgh which is fully accessible and has plentiful free parking.
