



## Former Volunteer Emily working as Nurse-Midwife in Malawi

Emily Stallings, who served at Global Links with AmeriCorps in 2009-10, now is the managing director of Access Health Africa (AHA). AHA's current work is focused on surgical camps where nurses and surgeons travel to Malawi to perform general surgeries and to train local providers. Emily shared, "An important component of any project like this is the redistribution of medical supplies...I now am working as a nurse-midwife...I returned to Malawi to assess for the creation of a midwifery program that might look something like AHA's surgical camps. As part of my trip, **I was able to coordinate with the Global Links Global Medical Partnership's program to carry over essential supplies** like suction tubing used to resuscitate neonates, nebulizers, and suture that will be used for obstetric patients and general surgeries, too. **It's such a pleasure to see Global Links continue to do their amazing work and grow their impact!** It's fulfilling to be able to connect my past, present and future in this way.
