Personal Care Kits Help Neighbors Feel Valued and Cared For

The Basic Needs/Personal Care Kit project serves low-income neighbors living in many areas of Western PA, reaching over forty zip codes. Our project aims to improve the health and dignity of low-income neighbors who qualify for SNAP benefits/food assistance. Our partner organizations consistently report that Personal Care Kits allow families to redirect limited resources toward food, medication, and rent. Beyond meeting a basic community health need, the program supports health, dignity, employability, and self-confidence, helping individuals and families feel valued and cared for during times of hardship.
